The following classes have a ** on the schedule and are non-NKHA point classes:

Horsemanship written test will be given in three age groups: Level I: 10 and under, Level II 11 –14, and Level III 15 and over. Places announced for each age group.

High Warm Up class will be a hunter over fences class to be judged on horse's style, ability, suitability, way of going, even hunting pace and manners. Fence heights will be the rider's choice. For the high warm up, riders may either choose 2', 2'6" or 3' jumps. In order to jump 2'6", this course must be completed prior to class # 10, the NKHA Medal. The card will not be held open during the medal. It will be reopened during the Open divisions for those riders wishing to compete at the 3' height. Those wishing to compete at 2' will do so during classes 20-24.

The Low Warm Up class will be a hunter over fences class to be judged on horse's style, ability, suitability, way of going, even hunting pace and manners. Fence heights will be the rider's choice. For the Low Warm Up, riders will choose to jump at either 18" or 2'. Those wishing to jump 18" must do so prior to class # 29, Schooling Hunter under saddle.

Leadline will be open to riders 10 and under. To be led at the walk both directions of the ring and asked horsemanship questions relevant to the rider's age and experience. All entrants given a participation ribbon. No entry fee.

Maiden Rider Equitation on the flat is **open to beginning riders who have not one a blue ribbon in equitation at an NKHA show.** To be judged on the rider's position, control of the horse and horse knowledge. To walk or walk/trot as indicated on class list.

Maiden Rider Equitation over ground poles will be judged on the rider's position, seat, hands, and effective control of the horse. To be shown over a course of 6-8 poles directly on the ground.

Maiden Rider Hunter Hack is to be a walk/trot under saddle judged on the horse's way of going open to horses **with beginning riders of any age who have not won a blue ribbon in a hunter class at an NKHA show.** After judging the horses under saddle walking and trotting both directions, the judge will ask riders to line up. Riders will then jump two jumps, as indicated by the ring master, and halt before returning to line. The class will be judged on the horse's manners, suitability, way of going and jumping form. 70% performance over the jumps, 30% performance under saddle on the rail.

- **NKHA membership dues/horse recording fees must be paid separately from entries. These are payable by check only. Please make check to NKHA.**
- **Entry fees: \$10 for members, \$15 for non members**
- **Helmet and shoes/boots with a heel are required when mounted.**
- **Each horse/rider combination must have a separate number(even in hunter classes!)**
- **Please park in designated areas only(parking attendant will indicate where trailers park)**
- **All dogs must be on a leash.**
- **Office fee will be \$5/horse**
- **\$10/rider ambulance fee**

- I-70(Topeka/KC), take exit 328, north on hwy 99 for 9 miles, west on hwy 24 for 7 miles, north on Flush Rd for 2.5 miles, west on Walker Road for .5 mile. Ashwood Farm is on your right(north).
- I-70(Salina/JC), take exit 303 into Manhattan, follow Ft. Riley Blvd to hwy 24, go east 6.3 miles from the mall, then follow above directions from Flush Road.
